

# RFABC Associates Scholarship

Established in 1991, the RFABC Associates Scholarship was introduced by RFABC Associate Members—companies and individuals providing products and services to the recreation industry—to support a deserving student enrolled in the Recreation Leadership Diploma Program at Langara College in Vancouver, BC.

This scholarship was initially advocated by early Associate Members, including Doug Churchill, Dave Gillette, and Dave Warner, who recognized the importance of investing in future leaders in recreation.

Over time, Perry Coleman and Norm Smith contributed to securing ongoing sponsorship and increasing the award's value. Originally, from 1991 to 2008, this award was granted to a second-year, full-time student with the highest GPA in their first term, honouring academic excellence within the program.
